Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, that the Oxfordshire County Council

**TEMPORARILY PROHIBITS THE USE OF AND WAITING ON THE HIGHWAY
BY ALL MOTOR VEHICLES**

LOCATION: Henley-on-Thames, Bell Street

REASON: Resurfacing works

DURATION: Starting on 11 September 2024 at 20:00hrs
The anticipated completion date is 12 September 2024
at 06:00hrs (one night road closure)

(Traffic Regulation Notices cover a maximum of 5
consecutive days)

ACCESS: Limited access will be maintained for emergency service
vehicles and for frontages within the closed section of
road, subject to the progress of the works

The “No Waiting” restriction means that wherever there are in place
yellow “No Waiting” cones, you will not be able to park vehicles on the
highway.

SUGGESTED ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: The alternative routes for traffic
are via a combination of Greys Road – 481 - A4130 and vice-versa.
